Network Downtime

In our continuing effort to improve the FPRN, we will be doing system upgrades beginning on

July 6, 2021 at 9:00 am edt.

We expect to have the system operational by the close of business July 6, 2021.

During this upgrade, we will be fortifying our network database, along with adding some additional software features.

Beidou Constellation

During this downtime we will be adding network processing to include the BeiDou constellation.

Station Down

Station ALEB (East Brewton, Alabama - ALDOT) has been knocked out of service by a tornado. The decision to rebuild has not been made. Keep tuned for additional information.

Network Solution

When using port **10000** to receive corrections you **MUST** turn on your NMEA (GGA) message string, and it must be set to broadcast at a rate of 30 seconds or less (we suggest 15 or 20 seconds).
